Sanction: This meet is sanctioned by USA Swimming and Indiana Swimming through the host, Portage Porpoise Swim Club. Sanction #IN09301.

Facility: Portage High School East Pool, 6450 E US RT6, enter through door "O" on north side of building. 6 Lane 25 meter pool with starting blocks, Daktronic timing system and pads, adjacent locker rooms and balcony spectator seating.

Rules: Current USA Swimming and Indiana Swimming rules will govern meet.

Entry Deadline: Entries accepted starting May 1, 2009. Deadline is May 29, 2009. Teams not accepted will be notified by 12pm May 31, 2009. No Teams will be split. We will extend deadline if meet is not full.

All payment and required paperwork for the meet should be sent to: PPSC PO BOX 2031 Portage, IN 46368, by June 9, 2009. Mailed entries must be received prior to meet entry deadline. No phone entries will be accepted.

Entry Format: Any file recognized by Meet Manager, create a standard meet entry file on your computer (CL2, HY3, SDIF or SDIF3) allow computer to zip file. Attach file to above e-mail.

Entry Fees: \$2.00/individual event, \$5.00/relay and \$1.50/swimmer surcharge. Deck entries will be permitted as long as four hour rule is still observed. Fees must accompany entry forms. Please make one check payable to PPSC. Entry fees for scratched events will not be refunded.

Entry Limits: There will be a 2 event limit on Friday, 4 individual and 2 relay entry limit on Saturday for all swimmers. ENTRIES WILL BE LIMITED TO STAY WITHIN THE 4 HOUR RULE. No teams will be broken.

Eligibility: ALL SWIMMERS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH USA SWIMMING. Swimmers age as of June 12, 2009 will determine age for entire meet. All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming. USA swimming registration numbers must accompany the entry. Coaches must constantly display their USA Swimming Coach Credentials to gain deck access. The Meet Director and/or Meet Referee reserve the right to deny deck access to anyone not in compliance with this rule. No parents allowed on deck.

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Check-In: This is a Positive Check-In Meet, all swimmers MUST check in 45 minutes prior to their sessions start time. Any swimmer scratched for missing deadline can have their coach/club representative petition for re-entry to Meet Director prior to the start of that session.

Heat Sheets: After scratch deadline, each club will receive a copy for each coaching representative on deck. Meet Programs can be purchased for \$5.00 at the concession stand.

Scoring: Individual Events: 1<sup>st</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup> Place 16-13-12-11-10-9-7-6-5-4-3-2  
Relay Events: 1<sup>st</sup> thru 6<sup>th</sup> Place 32-26-24-22-20-18  
Open and 10 and Under events will be scored according to the established Individual High Point age categories.

Open Events: Minimum Age for Open events is 11yrs old

Awards: Individual Events: 1<sup>st</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> ribbons  
Relay Events: 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> ribbons

Individual High Point Awards for the following Age Groups for males and females: 8 & under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14 and 15 & over.

Warm -up Schedule: Friday Warm-Ups (Session #1)-5:00-5:45pm  
Saturday Morning Warm-Ups (Session #2)-7:00-7:45am  
Saturday Afternoon Warm-Ups (Session #3)  
**NOT BEFORE NOON (12:00pm)**  
45 min warm-up session will take place 15minutes after conclusion of session #2

Start Times: Friday Night/Session #1 6:00pm  
Saturday Morning/Session #2 8:00am  
Saturday Afternoon/Session #3 1hr after start of warm-ups, not before 1pm

Clerk of the Course: All 8 and Under events will be Clerked. There will be NO CLERK for 10 and Under Events!

ENTRY NOTE: Coaches and Team Entry Chairs, there are both 8 & under and 10 & Under events available during the meet. PLEASE remember to allow for proper rest for your swimmer when selecting events. ALL 8 and Under events will be clerked Saturday Morning/Session #2

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Entry Rules: USA Swimming Rule 202.3.3-At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition and warm down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee shall assist the athlete in making arrangements for such supervision.

Over Entries/Full Meet: In the event that the meet or events are filled refunds will be offered to those clubs/swimmers that did not make the meet or event.

Send the following to host club:

- Check for payment of all entry fees
- Executed release and hold harmless agreement
- Official sign-up sheet
- Summary page with checklist/statement of desired Form of Results

Updates to previously accepted entries will be accepted until June 8<sup>th</sup> but may not be reflected in meet programs.

Concessions: Will be available during all sessions

**INDIANA SWIMMING LEGISLATION BELOW**  
**102.9 Swimwear - Page 28 of USA Swimming Rules**

**A. Swim suits worn by 12 and under males participating in all Indiana Swimming sanctioned "age group" competitions will not extend above the navel or below the knees.**

**B. Swim suits worn by 12 and under females participating in all Indiana Swimming sanctioned "age group" competitions will not cover the neck, extend past the shoulders; extend beyond the shoulder, nor below the pelvis.**

**C. Swimsuits worn for competition must be non-transparent and conform to the current concept of appropriate.**

**D. The referee shall have the authority to bar offenders from the competition until they comply with the rule.**

***Informational Note: Additional language to clarify that 12 & under swimmers participating in senior events are not subject to this provision is not needed because of the following articles:***

**Rule 205.4: AGE GROUP ELIGIBILITY - A swimmer must compete in the age group events corresponding to the swimmer's age except when competing in consolidating events, mixed classification events and in events combined by the referee.**

**Rule 204.2: SENIOR ELIGIBILITY – All registered swimmers are eligible to compete in the Senior Class.**
